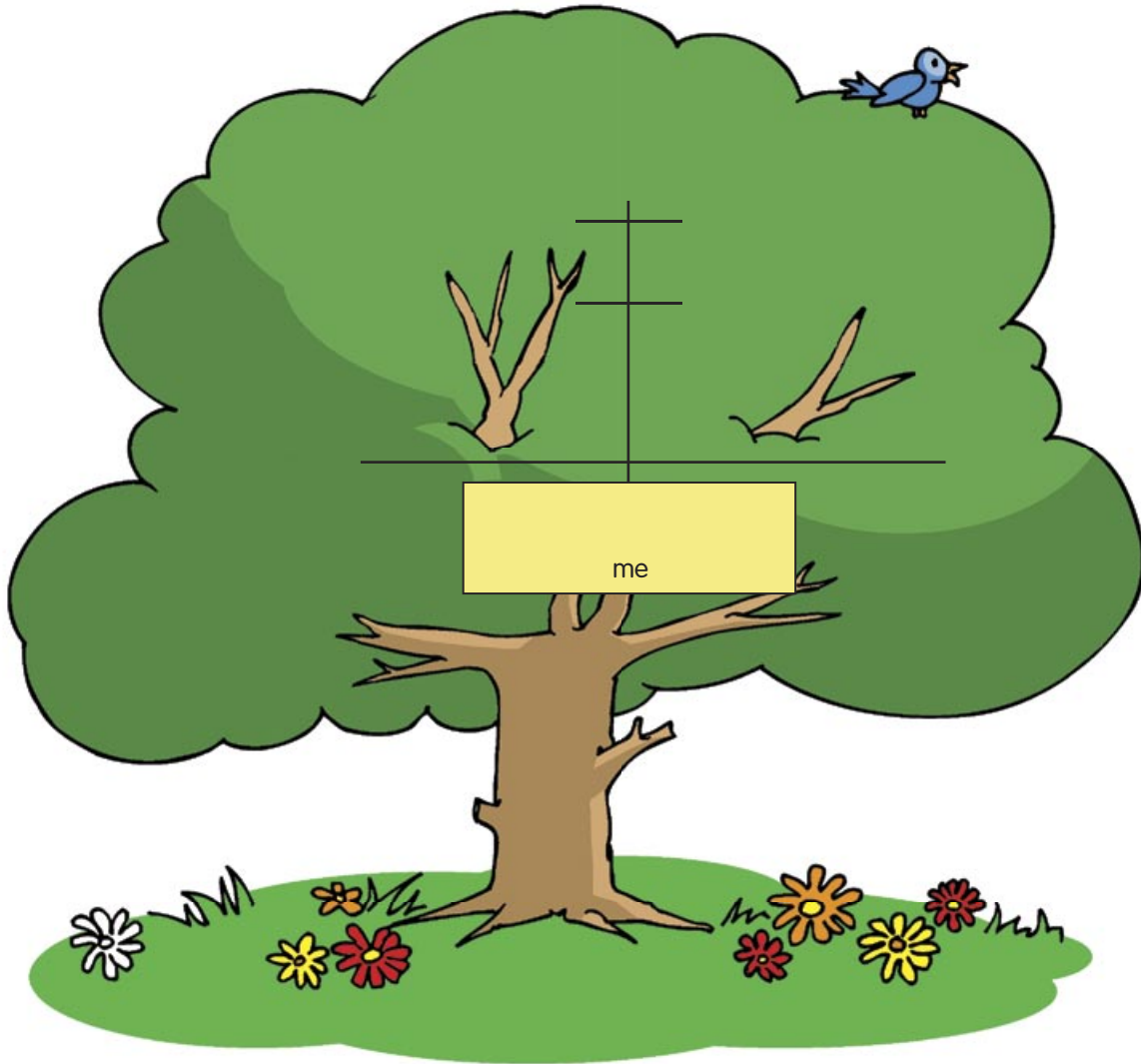

Make a table of what you like/dislike about your city or town. Find photos.

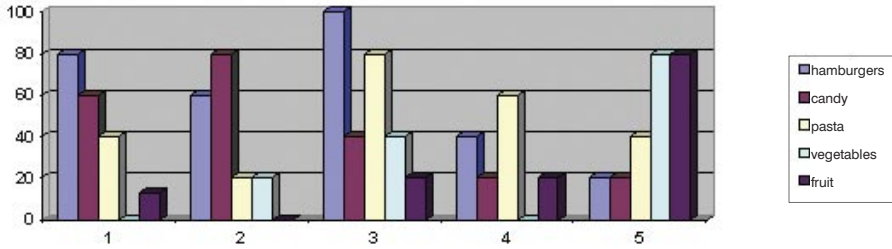


<i>What I like about my city/town</i>	<i>What I dislike about my city/town</i>

Interview five of them and find out. Make a bar chart like the one below and then write a paragraph with your findings.

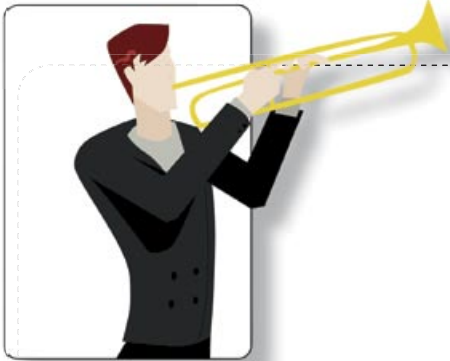


Project 5
