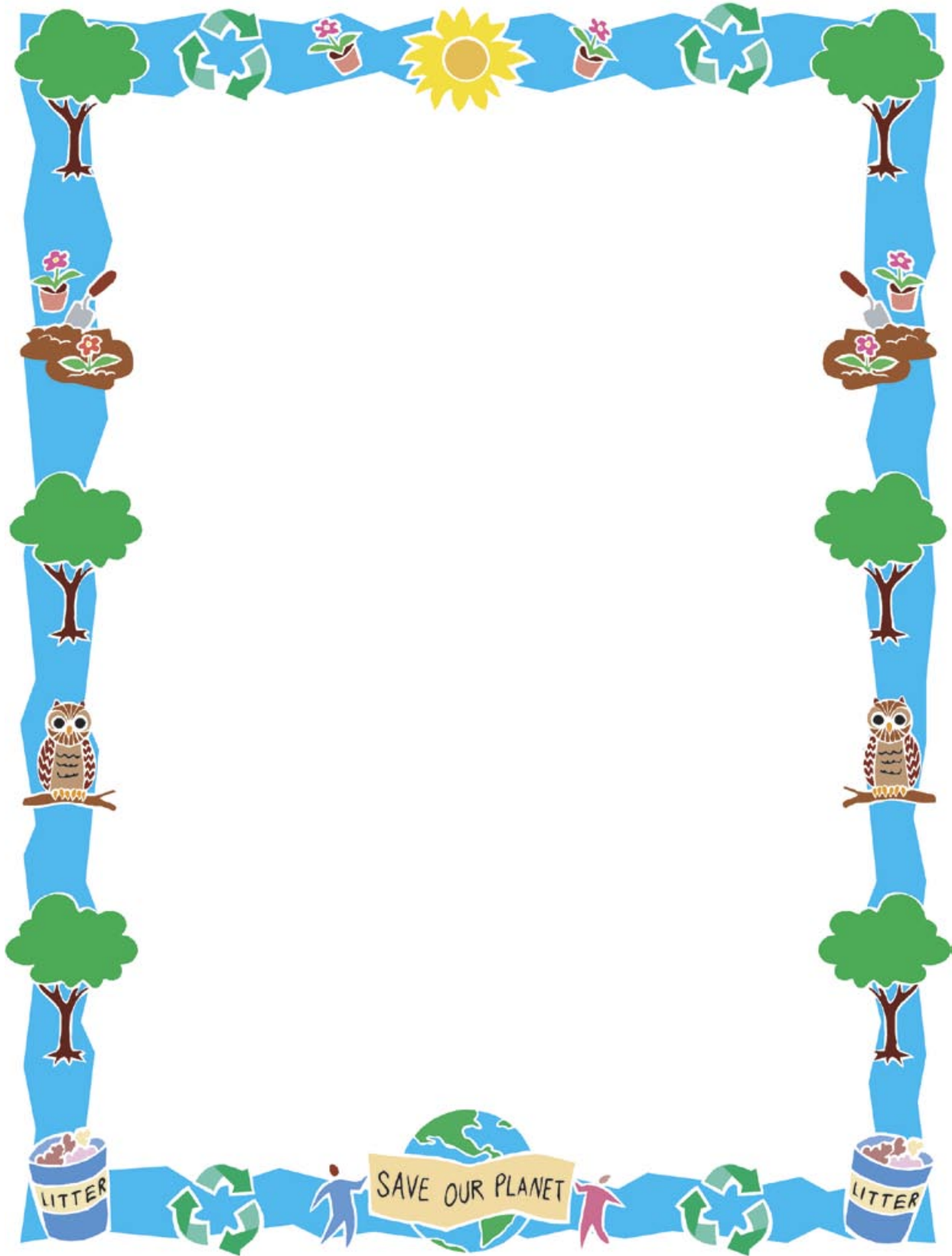
My favourite free-time activity is just hanging out with my friends.

Channel Pre-Intermediate

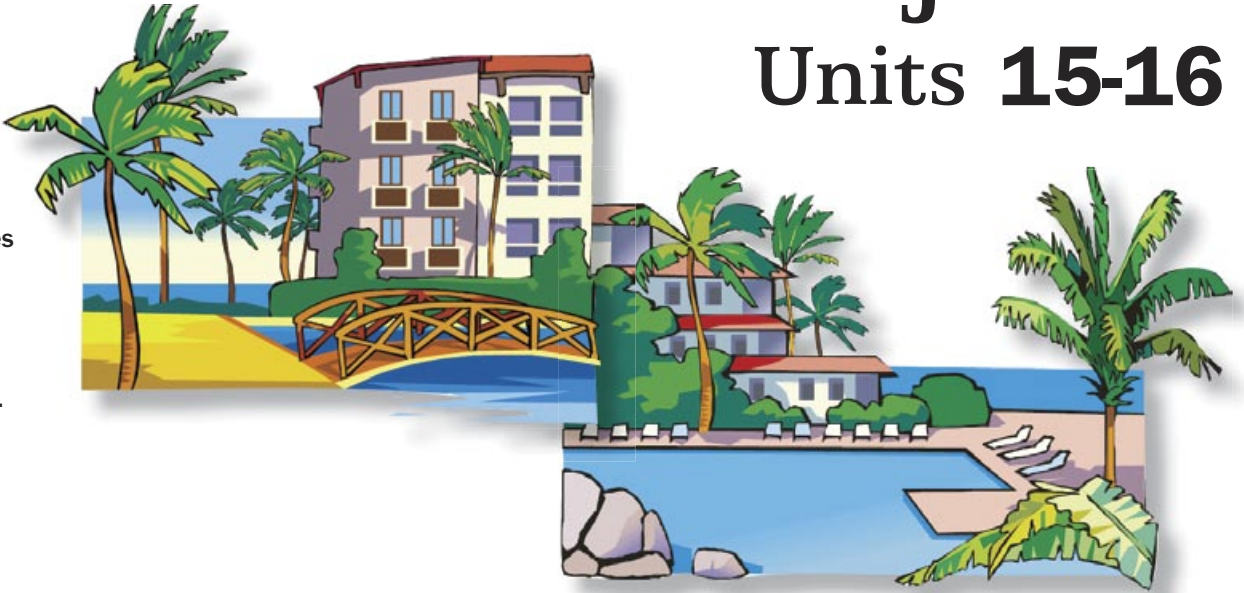
